Welcome to The New Albany Community Foundation's Performance Series at the Hinson Amphitheater in New Albany

GETTING THERE AND PARKING:

Parking is readily available near the amphitheater and in and around New Albany's Market Square area. See the attached map for more detailed information.

The address for the Hinson Amphitheater is: 170 W. Granville Street, New Albany. It is located across from BrewDog and adjacent to the Jeanne B. McCoy Community Center for the Arts on the campus of New Albany Schools.

While driving to and parking at the venue, please be mindful of pedestrians.

TIMING:

Gates open for picnicking at 7pm. The performance begins at 8pm and will conclude around 9:30pm

WHAT TO BRING:

IF YOU PURCHASED LAWN TICKETS: Please bring a blanket or lawn chairs for your comfort. Please be mindful of lawn seat neighbors—the more room guests take the less space there will be for others.

IF YOU PURCHASED A TABLE OR INDIVIDUAL

TABLES SEATS: Your table will include 8 chairs and a tablecloth. You are welcome to bring a centerpiece or table décor. So that views are not obstructed for other table patrons, please make sure table décor does not exceed 12-14 inches in height.

PICNIC: All guests are responsible for their own food for the evening. If you do not bring your own food there will be some food trucks on site. If you'd like to purchase a catered meal our beverage partner, BrewDog, is offering an amphitheater carryout menu that can be pre-ordered and picked up before the performance.

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BEVERAGES: Carrying alcohol into the venue for this performance is prohibited.

BrewDog will be on site to sell both beer and wine for the evening at a cost of \$10 per serving. Proceeds from beer and wine sales benefit The New Albany Community Foundation's amphitheater programming.

Alcohol tickets will be sold via credit card or cash at the Amphitheater main gate area. Guests must provide proof of age to purchase an alcohol ticket.

Please do not carry alcohol into the venue. Open flames, firearms, fireworks or grills are prohibited. Bring LED lights if you want a candlelight effect for your picnic.

COVID PROTOCOL:

As an outdoor venue, guests can make their own determination about whether they wear a mask or not. If there is a change for COVID protocol from the Franklin County Department of Health at the time of the performance, the Foundation will follow the new recommended guidelines.

WHAT ABOUT WEATHER?

The performances will happen rain or shine. If severe weather occurs, guests will be directed to vacate the venue for their cars or in case of a tornado, The McCoy Center for the Arts.

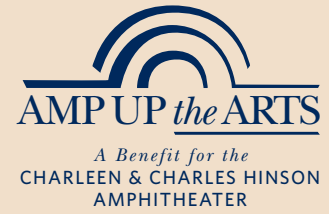
