

Presidential historian and Pulitzer Prize-winning author Jon Meacham is one of America's most prominent public intellectuals.







In many ways, Sara's advocacy for mindful living and integrative health has heightened awareness and driven demand for programming particularly focused on children and young adults offered by Healthy New Albany and the Well-Being Connection. They have personally hosted numerous mindfulness and Urban Zen based yoga retreats, including one focused specifically on cancer survivors, and supported children's nature programming. Their support of the Well-Being Connection has included hosting a fundraiser and supporting and hosting restorative yoga programs.






