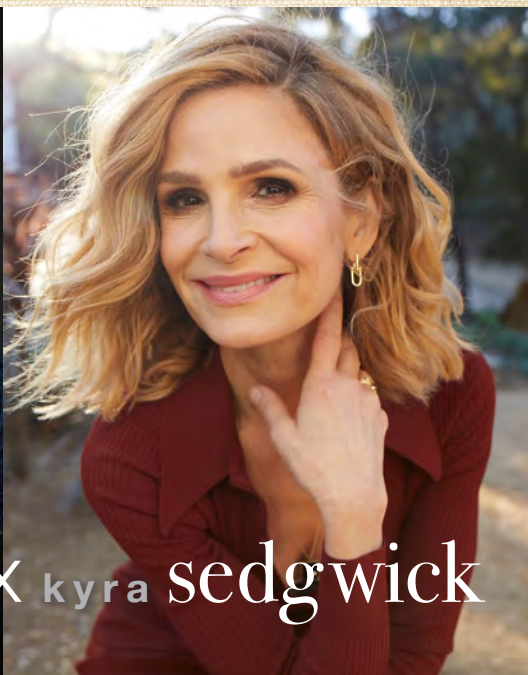

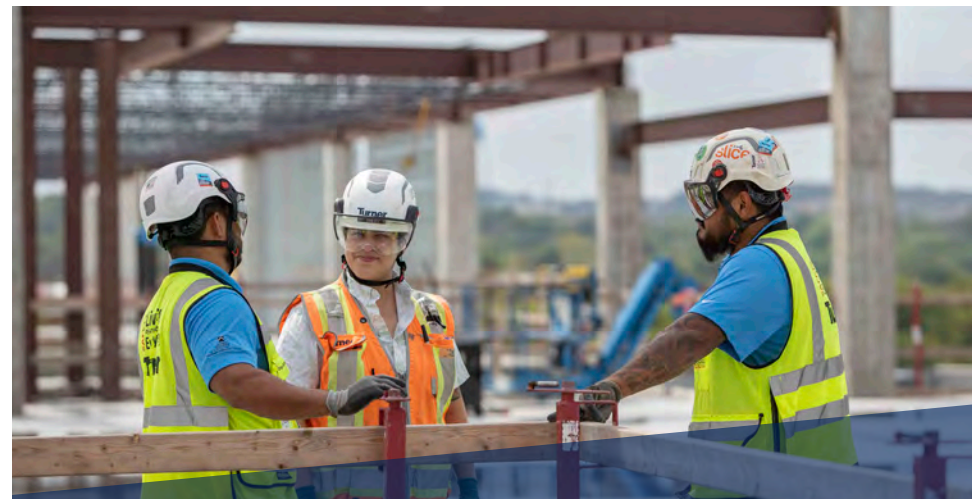

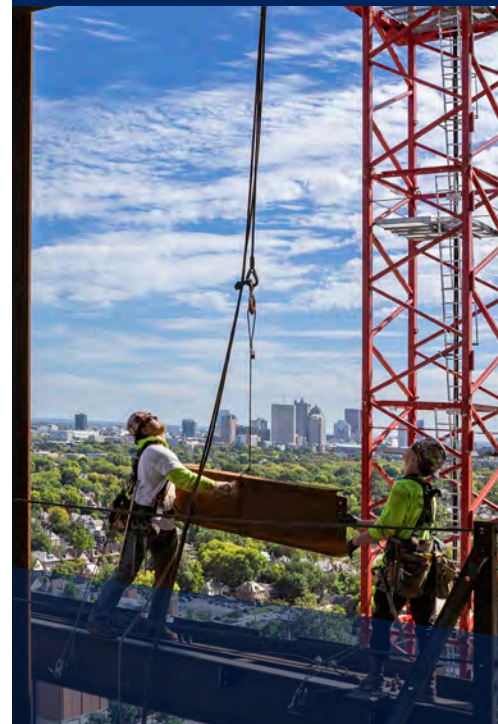

Tonight, The New Albany Community Foundation celebrates 30 years of impact. More than anything, this is a celebration of your impact as donors and supporters of the Foundation. So I want to begin the evening by thanking you, not only for advancing our community's aspirations, but for creating a culture of giving and caring that defines our community.

To help us celebrate, we welcome an iconic couple who has entertained us for decades in films and on stage and television, all while making a profound difference through their philanthropy. Decorated actors and directors of film and television with careers spanning decades, Kyra and Kevin also are respected for their philanthropic focus through the sixdegrees.org platform and the Food Bank of New York. Sharing their life together, their love of music and the movies, and as community advocates with a combined five million followers on social media, Kyra currently stars in “Bad Shabbos” in select theaters across the country and Kevin is currently touring the country with his band The Bacon Brothers, among other projects. They both recently starred in the Michael J. Weithorn-directed film “The Best You Can” and are also set to direct and star in the horror-comedy project “Family Movie” alongside their children, Travis Bacon and Sosie Bacon.

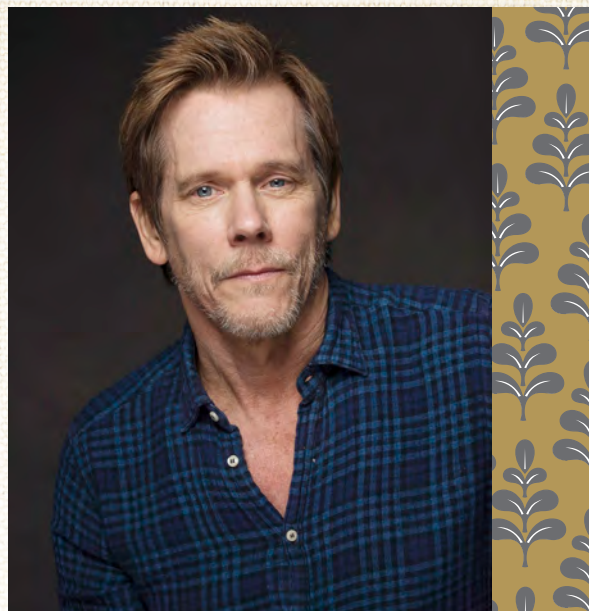
Kevin's film credits include "Footloose," "Tremors," "A Few Good Men," "The River Wild," "Mystic River," "Apollo 13," "The Woodsman," "Crazy Stupid Love," "Black Mass," "Patriots Day," "Space Oddity" and most recently "Leave the World Behind," "Beverly Hills Cop: Axel F" and "MaXXXine."

On the small screen, Kevin starred in the HBO film "Taking Chance," for which he won Golden Globe and SAG Awards. For three seasons he starred in the hit Fox series "The Following." He starred in Jill Soloway's Amazon series "I Love Dick" for which he earned a Golden Globe Award nomination. He also starred in the hit Showtime series, "City on a Hill" alongside Aldis Hodge for three seasons. In addition to starring in the series, Kevin served as an executive producer and he directed the first episode of the second season. Most recently, Kevin Bacon starred in an executive produced Blumhouse action horror series "The Bondsman," and was seen in the limited Netflix series "Sirens" with Julianne Moore.

In addition to acting, Kevin is one half of The Bacon Brothers band. The band has released twelve albums to date.

Kevin founded SixDegrees.org, an organization that encourages people to connect and become a celebrity for their cause by raising money for local and grassroots charities in the United States.

As an extension of SixDegrees.org, Kevin launched his own podcast, "Six Degrees with Kevin Bacon," where he speaks with celebrities about the causes they care most about. Every episode also features the extraordinary changemakers behind these charitable organizations, who share inspirational stories about their efforts to motivate and bring about positive change in their communities. ~



KYRA SEDGWICK is an award-winning actress, producer and director whose film and television work has captured and defined the zeitgeist, establishing her as a generational talent and icon. Her leading role in the hit series "The Closer" earned her both an Emmy Award* and a Golden Globe*.

Sedgwick currently stars alongside Kevin Bacon and Judd Hirsch in the feature film "The Best You Can" written and directed by Michael J. Weithorn. The film had its world premiere at the 2025 Tribeca Film Festival and is currently available to stream on demand. Sedgwick's next film, the American romantic crime thriller "Carolina Caroline" directed by Adam Rehmeier premiered at the 2025 Toronto International Film Festival and was acquired by Magnolia Pictures. Recently, Sedgwick and Cliff "Method Man" Smith lead an incredible ensemble cast in the uproarious new comedy "Bad Shabbos," winner of the Audience Award for Best Narrative at the Tribeca Film Festival and now available to stream on demand.

Sedgwick's previous film roles include "Born on the Fourth of July," "Singles," "Phenomenon," "Something to Talk About," "The Possession," and "The Edge of Seventeen". On television, Sedgwick most recently starred in Kari Lizer's ABC comedy series Call Your Mother and the second season of the beloved Amazon series "The Summer I Turned Pretty" opposite Elsie Fisher. Previously, she had a recurring role as "Madeline Wuntch" on "Brooklyn Nine-Nine".

Sedgwick's previous directing credits include the feature films "Space Oddity" starring Kyle Allen and Alexandra Shipp, "Story of a Girl," which earned her a DGA Award nomination, and "Girls Weekend," which premiered at the Sundance Film Festival. Sedgwick has contributed her directing talents to notable series such as "Ray Donovan," "City on a Hill," "Grace and Frankie" and others.

As a producer, Sedgwick's production company, Big Swing, along with Amblin Entertainment, is producing the highly-anticipated limited series "The Challenger," starring Kristen Stewart, for Amazon Studios. ~

ARI SHAPIRO is an award-winning journalist who spent 25 years at NPR, including a decade as host of the evening news program *All Things Considered* and the podcast *Consider This*.

He has reported from above the Arctic Circle and aboard Air Force One.



He has been a question on *Jeopardy* and an answer in the *New York Times* crossword puzzle. His debut memoir, “The Best Strangers in the World: Stories From a Life Spent Listening,” was an instant *New York Times* bestseller. He also hosts the reality competition show, “The Mole,” on Netflix.

As a journalist, he has won three Edward R. Murrow awards. As a performer, he has sung at Carnegie Hall, the Hollywood Bowl, and many of the world’s other leading venues with the band Pink Martini. He also

tours the country with the actor Alan Cumming in their original two man show, “Och & Oy: A Considered Cabaret” as well as with his own original solo show, “Thank You For Listening: An Evening of Songs and Stories.”

He was born in Fargo, North Dakota and grew up in Portland, Oregon. He lives in Washington, DC with his husband and two dogs. ~
