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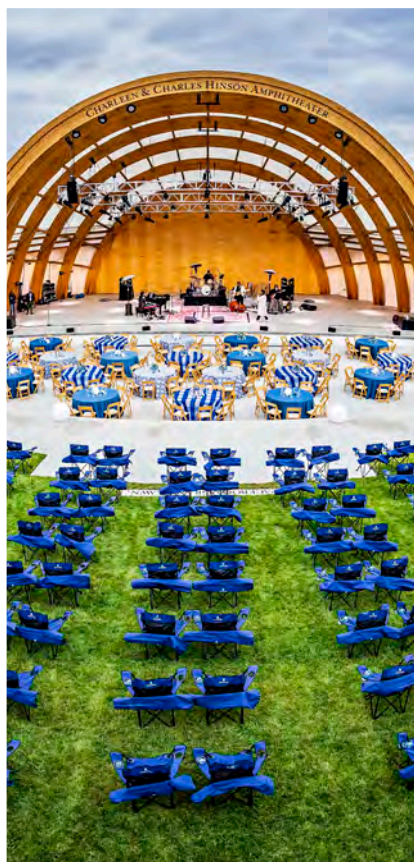
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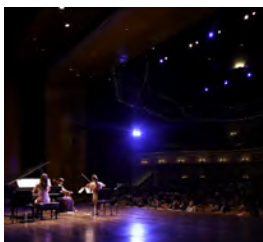

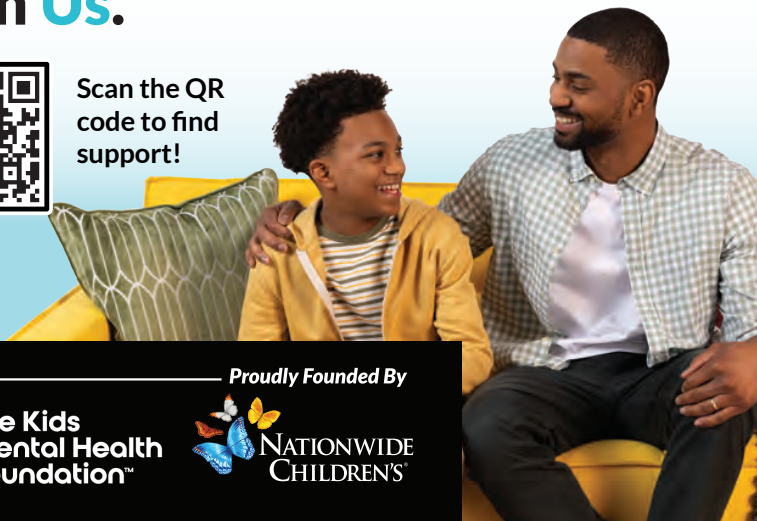

Safety Town is a day-camp for children entering kindergarten or first grade designed to teach life skills to promote safety. The program teaches safety life skills in areas such as pedestrian & bike safety, stranger awareness, fire safety, water safety, animal safety and school bus safety. The Foundation convened the New Albany Police Department and the Plain Township Fire Department to develop the program. **Historically, 7335 campers have benefitted from this valuable learning experience.**
